Salem University provides complete graduation, retention and other statistics to the general public, including prospective students, as required by the US Department of Education (“ED”) via the integrated Postsecondary Educational Data System (“IPEDS”). This is the latest graduation rate based on the IPEDS report. These statistics are for full time, first time (FTFT) students who began their studies In the Full-Year Cohort of 2013 and graduated within 150% of the defined “normal time” to complete their program. Salem has supplemented this information with data for Transfer-in students as well as student-athletes as reported to the NCAA annually.
